Ground Floor

Lounge:	Open plan downstairs contemporary living area with beamed ceiling, window seats, stone fireplace with gas effect log burner, 43" LED TV including full Netflix subscription and DVD Recorder.
Kitchen Area:	Fully fitted kitchen area equipped with electric cooker, dishwasher, fridge, microwave, kettle and toaster.

Shops:	Local shop 2 minutes walk.
Nearest Town:	Pickering town centre is 5 minutes walk, has extensive shopping including a small supermarket (Market day is Monday).
Public Transport:	Pickering is well served by bus routes, there is a bus stop within 100 yards of the cottage, we are happy to meet you and help with the luggage. Nearest rail station is in Malton 10 miles from Pickering.
Eating Out:	Pickering has many restaurants and takeaways most within easy walk of the cottages. There is a file in the cottage with sample menus for many local restaurants.
Places to visit and things to do:	We are within walking distance of the North Yorkshire Moors steam railway, Pickering Castle, Beck Isle Museum and the swimming pool. Pickering is on the edge of the North Yorkshire National Park, fantastic for walking or site seeing.
